Sand

The recipe for Sand is quite simple. You may have had or made Dirt before, so I made it blond.

Use 2 cups of vanilla pudding (instant, cooked from a mix, or homemade). I had some you cook from a mix, so I made it. After the pudding is cool, fold in an 8 oz container of Cool Whip (or generic brand). Crush a 16 oz package of vanilla sandwich cookies. Stir in 3/4 of it. Pour into a sand pail. Sprinkle remaining cookie

crumbs on top to make it look like sand.

Decorate with edible sea creatures or something you take to the beach. Serve with a sand shovel. If you serve it soon after you make it, it will have more of a sand texture throughout. Since I made it the night before, it got pretty smooth.

To make Dirt, use chocolate pudding and chocolate sandwich cookies instead. Decorate with gummy worms or bugs
