

# Stitches From The Heart Quilt Show 2016 JUDGING

GENERAL CATEGORIES – first/second/third in each category (white form) These categories will be judged on the overall aesthetic of the quilt.

## 1. BED QUILTS - ANY SIZE-original design

Quilts designs must be original design of the entrant. These quilts can be pieced/applique both by machine or hand. All elements of the bed quilt must be created and constructed by the entrant.

## 2. BED QUILTS – ANY SIZE- published patterns/kits/workshops

Quilts may be applique or pieced both machine or by hand and made from published patterns from books, internet sites, kits or workshops.

## 3. WALL QUILTS-ANY SIZE-original design

Quilts designs must be original using traditional blocks or published patterns that are public domain or are an original design. These quilts can be pieced/applique both by machine or hand. All elements of the wall quilt must be created and constructed by the entrant.

### 4. WALL QUILTS-ANY SIZE – published patterns/kits/workshops

Quilts may be applique or pieced both machine or by hand and made from published patterns from books, internet sites, kits or workshops.

## 5. MODERN WALL & BED QUILTS-published pattern or original design

The modern design quilts generally make use of solid fabrics, negative space, minimalism, asymmetry and simple graphic shapes and colours. These quilts can be made from a pattern/kit/book/workshop/internet site etc. or can be an original design.

### 6. MINIATURE

These quilts must be patterns that represent a pattern at a reduced scale. It can be no bigger than 96" in perimeter in total and if blocks are used they can be no more than 4" x 4". These quilts can be made from a pattern/kit/book/workshop/internet site etc. or can be an original design.

#### 7. WEARABLES & ACCESSORIES

This category includes clothing (jackets, skirts, tops, dresses etc.), purses and totes, zipper pouches, wallets, hats, shoes etc. it must have some aspect of quilting in the design-applique, piecing or quilting.

#### 8. ART QUILTS – ABSTRACT

This category includes any original quilted item that is non-literal, cutting edge or abstract. It can be a wall hanging or bed quilt that has 3 dimensional qualities or can be a free standing or sculptural piece. (eg. Quilted journal pages bound into books, quilts using recycled materials etc.) All elements of the art quilt-abstract must be created and constructed by the entrant.

#### 9. ART QUILTS - PICTORAL

These quilts must be original designs and must be landscapes, seascapes, cityscapes, still life, animals or portraits. All elements of the art quilt-pictoral must be created and constructed by the entrant.

## AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE – one prize in each category

#### 1. HAND QUILTING

Quilts will be judged on the overall quality of the hand quilting. That includes the stitches and the quilting design.

#### 2. MACHINE PIECING

These quilts will be judged on the quality and precision of the machine piecing only.

#### 3. HAND PIECING

These quilts will be judged on the quality and precision of the hand piecing only.

## 4. HAND APPLIQUE

All the appliqued pieces must be hand stitched and the quilt will be judged on the quality and precision of the hand applique only.

### 5. MACHINE APPLIQUE

All the appliqued pieces must be done by a machine and the quilt will be judged on the quality and precision of the machine applique only.

## 6. MACHINE QUILTING (domestic machine)

This includes the use of any sewing machine that is table-mounted/stationary allowing the quilter (operator) to move the fabric rather than the machine. The quilts will be judged on the quality of the quilting stitches and the quilting design.

#### 7. LONG/MID ARM MACHINE QUILTING

This includes any sewing machine mounted on a frame allowing the quilter (operator) to move the machine head rather than the fabric. Quilts are judged on the quality of the quilting stitches and the quilting designs.

#### 8. VIEWERS CHOICE

This category is chosen by the general public via a ballot –it is awarded on the afternoon of the last day of the show.

### 9. BEST OF SHOW/JUDGES CHOICE

This is chosen by the judges as a quilt that shows exceptional workmanship and design. This quilt may be original or from a published pattern, kit or workshop.

#### **NON-JUDGING CATEGORIES (DISPLAY ONLY)**

## 1. YOUTH QUILTS (GREEN FORMS)

(must be 18 years or under and have a relative (parent, grandparent, aunt/uncle etc.) that is a member in good standing)

### 2. CHALLENGE QUILTS (BLUE FORMS)

(are the items that are entries in the guild challenge set out for the show)

## 3. NOT FOR JUDGING QUILTS (PINK FORMS)

This category includes quilts that the owner does not want judged –this category also includes antique quilts.

## **DEFINITIONS:**

#### **MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING**

IS A MEMBER WHO HAS THEIR MEMBERSHIP DUES PAID UP ON OR BEFORE **DECEMBER 31, 2015**.
